ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS: Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs and dogs with Limited Registration provided they are classified as eligible breeds. Dogs of an eligible breed that have been granted Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules.

The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests: Dachshunds, Miniature Schnauzers, and the following Terriers: Australian, Belington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wirehaired), Glen of Imaal, Parson Russell, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Norfolk, Norwich, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, and West Highland White. Dogs that are blind and deaf shall not be eligible.

Dogs may enter only one regular class (Introduction to Quarry is non-regular) at an Earthdog test. The Senior Earthdog class is open only to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title prior to the closing of entries. The Master Earthdog class is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title before the closing of entries.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season shall not be refunded. Should the committee or the Judge deems conditions are unsafe to run or continue the test, no refund of entry fees will be made.

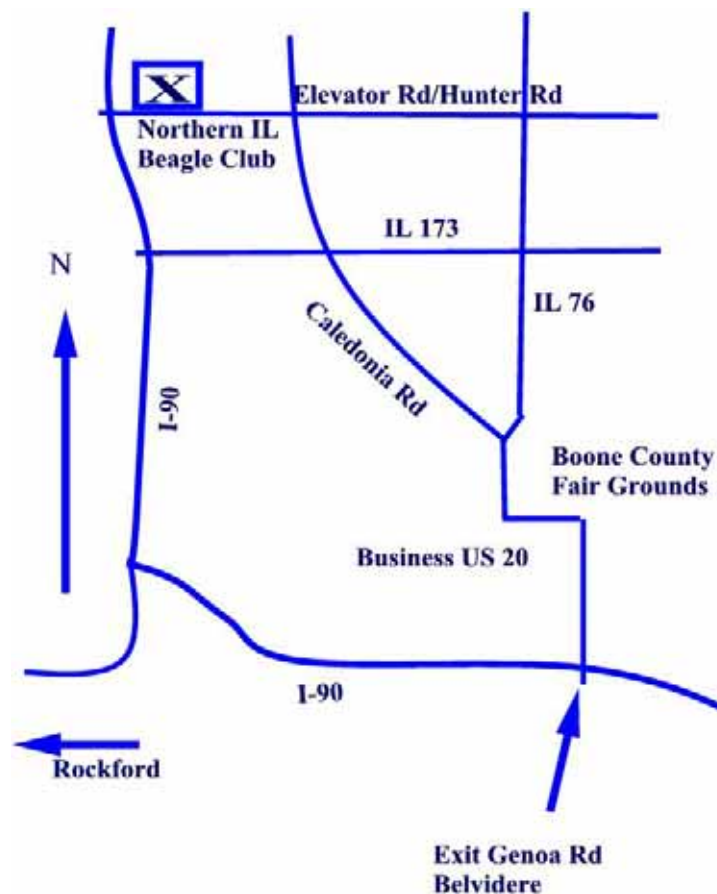
RUNNING ORDER: Dogs will be run in the order that entries are received with consideration given to dogs being handled by the same handler. Dogs and their handlers for the Master Earthdog class must be present on the grounds for roll call and bracing. **Move ups will be honored.**

AWARDS: Rosettes are offered to all qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Classes. Ribbons are offered for all qualifiers in Introduction to Quarry.

Roscoe, IL is east of Rockford, IL and south of Beloit, WI
FROM THE CHICAGO AREA

I-90 North to Genoa Road - Belvidere
Genoa Road North to IL 76 (Boone County Fairgrounds are on the right)
(Genoa Road changes names, crosses IL 20 & becomes Business 20 just continue on this road until you reach IL 76)
IL 76 North (right) to Caledonia Road
Turn left at Caledonia Road (Landscape Company on the left corner)
Continue until Caledonia Road ends at Hunter Rd
Turn left – Hunter Road becomes Elevator Road in Roscoe
The Beagle Club is on the North Side of Elevator Road



Intro to Quarry B will be available to enter at the test site.

The second intro class is offered as an effort to provide more tunnel and quarry experience for the dogs and handlers that are new to the sport. It will be judged the same as Intro to Quarry A. We do not recommend Intro B for those dogs that are also entered in Junior or Senior. If the dog entered in Intro A does not pass or the Judge suggests entering the Intro B for more experience the fee for Intro B entry will be \$4.00. Gate Entries of dogs not entered in Intro A will remain \$8.00.

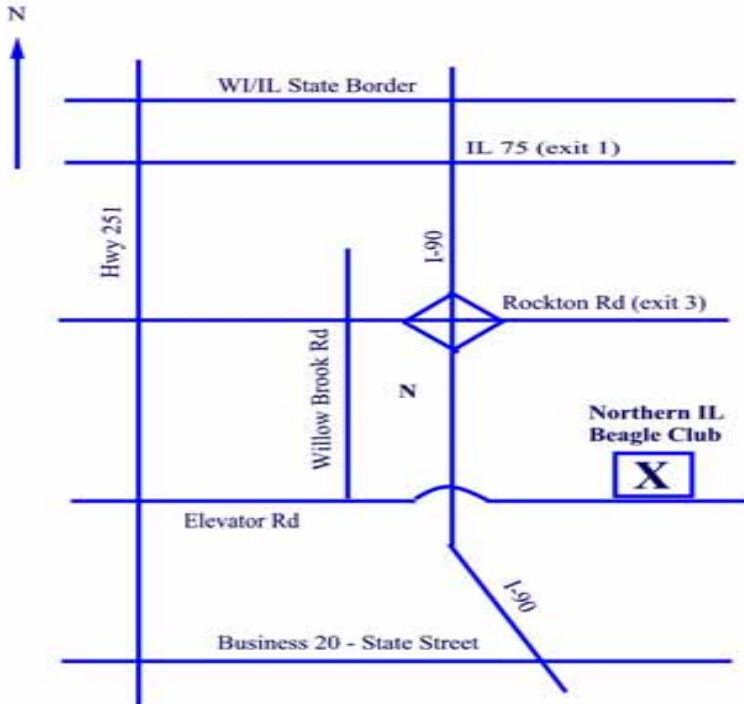
