These Earthdog Tests will be held under the Rules and Procedures of the American Kennel Club

Lunch will be offered on Saturday and Sunday for a nominal fee.

ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS: Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs and dogs with Limited Registration provided they are classified as eligible breeds. Dogs of an eligible breed that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) or a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Bitches in season are not allowed.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Please be ready to show proof of Rabies vaccination.

The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests: Dachshunds, Miniature Pinschers, Miniature Schnauzers, and the following Terriers: American Hairless, Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wirehaired), Glen of Imaal, Jagdterrier, Japanese, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Teddy Roosevelt, Welsh, West Highland White and Yorkshire. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible.

Dogs may enter more than one regular class at an Earthdog test provided the dog is eligible for the class. The Novice Earthdog class is open **only to dogs who have not previously earned an Earthdog title.** The Senior Earthdog class is open only to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title prior to the closing of entries. The Master Earthdog class is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title before the closing of entries. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season shall be refunded. Should the committee or the Judge deem conditions are unsafe to run or continue the test, no refund of entry fees will be made.

RUNNING ORDER: Dogs will be run in the order that entries are received with consideration given to dogs being handled by the same handler.

BARKING. This is a residential area. The barking of dogs must be kept under control **at all times, including dogs in x-pens during the tests.** Winnebago County fines range from \$50-\$500 for nuisance barking complaints. The Earthdog Test Committee will enforce this rule, up to and including AKC misconduct charges.

CLUBHOUSE: No dogs allowed in the clubhouse.

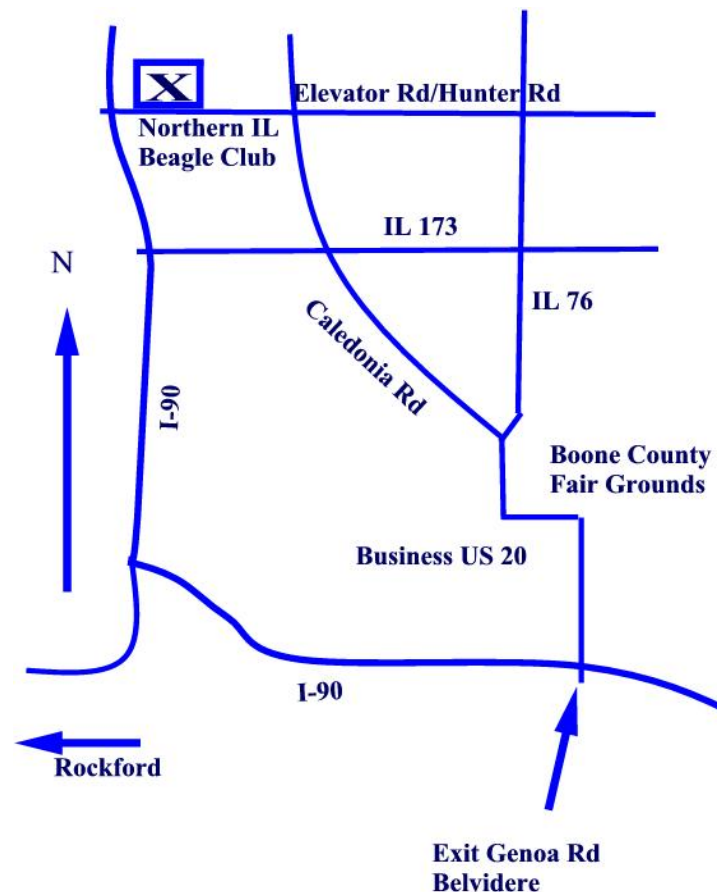
AWARDS: Rosettes are offered to qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Classes, except those competing for Endurance Earthdog legs. Ribbons are offered for all qualifiers in Introduction to Quarry. Rosettes are offered for new titles.

NEW CLASS

Novice Earthdog Class and Title (NE). The Novice Earthdog class is open to all eligible breeds of dogs (see Chapter 1, Section 6) **who have not previously earned an Earthdog title**. In order to be recorded as a Novice Earthdog, a dog must be individually registered with the AKC, and must have a record of having qualified in the Novice Earthdog test in two (2) AKC licensed or member club tests under two different judges.

This new class offers a NE title after having earned two passes. The Novice class is an instinct test requiring very little previous exposure to earthwork. It is very similar to Intro to Quarry except the handler and judge may not provide encouragement once the dog is released. A NE title will not be a prerequisite to entering the Junior class.

NEW TITLES

Any dog that has completed the requirements for the Junior, Senior or Master Earthdog title shall be eligible to earn legs toward the Earthdog Excellent title. In order to earn an Excellent title, a dog must on six occasions pass the Junior, Senior or Master level test respectively after the dog has earned its JE, SE or ME title. The Excellent title by level is Junior Excellent Earthdog (JXE), Senior Excellent Earthdog (SXE) and Master Excellent Earthdog (MXE). The Excellent title will supersede the standard title in any given level. For example, the JXE title will supersede the JE title on a dog's pedigree. The Excellent title may be earned repeatedly. A number will appear after the title for every six additional passes. For example, a dog that passes the Junior test six times after earning the JXE title will be awarded the JXE2 title. An Excellent numeric title will supersede a lower Excellent title of the same test level on a dog's pedigree. Legs that count toward a dog's Excellent title may also be counted toward a dog's Endurance Earthdog title.
