**Please note:** The staging area for Master Earthdog is approximately 300 yards from the parking area. The staging area for Introduction to Quarry and Senior Earthdog is near the gate to the running grounds. The staging area for Junior Earthdog is marked inside the running grounds with flags. Do not encroach on the test area while waiting. Dogs must remain quiet and under control in the staging areas. Exhibitors should be prepared to stay informed of the running order.



# **Directions to Northern Illinois Brace Club in Roscoe, Illinois**

From I-39 /I-90, go to Rockton Road (Exit #3). Go East on Rockton Road to County Line Road (second stop sign). Take County Line Road South to Elevator Road (first stop sign). Go West on Elevator Road .3 miles. NIBC will be on the North side of Elevator Road.

From I-43 go to Highway 140 (Exit #6). Go South on Highway 140. After about 5 miles Highway 140 curves at the State Line and becomes Highway 76. Continue for 4.5 miles to Hunter Road. Take Hunter Road to the West (right) for about 6 miles to NIBC on the North side of Elevator Road (Hunter Road becomes Elevator Road at the County Line .3 miles before NIBC).



# **OUR RULES & THINGS YOU REALLY WANT TO KNOW**

**AWARDS:** Ribbons or rosettes will be awarded for qualifiers in all tests, except there will be no ribbon or rosette for single test qualifiers if entered as "EE". A single rosette will be awarded for EE qualifiers.

**BARKING.** This is a residential area. The barking of dogs must be kept under control **at all times, including dogs in x-pens during the tests**. Winnebago County fines range from \$50-\$500 for nuisance barking complaints.

**CAMPING/PARKING:** Overnight camping is available at the grounds. A donation of \$20 per night for camping with water and electric hook-ups, \$15 per night with electric only and \$10 per night for overnight parking/camping in the parking lot or clubhouse is requested. There is no charge for day parking. Please leave a walkway between the white stakes in the parking area. This walkway is required for safety purposes and should be clear of chairs, crates, canopies, x-pens, tables, etc.. If this is not self-monitored, you may be requested to move your stuff from this area. For those staying on the grounds, quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. During this time, please keep outside lights off, dogs quiet, and noise to a minimum.

**CLUBHOUSE:** No dogs allowed in the clubhouse.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Dogs may enter more than one regular class at an Earthdog test provided the dog is eligible for the class as defined in Chapter 3.

The following breeds are eligible to participate in Earthdog Events: American Hairless Terrier, Australian Terrier, Bedlington Terrier, Border Terrier, Cairn Terrier, Cesky Terrier, Dachshund, Dandie Dinmont Terrier, Glen of Imaal Terrier, Jagdterrier, Japanese Terrier, Lakeland Terrier, Manchester Terrier, Miniature Bull Terrier, Miniature Pinschers, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk Terrier, Norwich Terrier, Parson Russell Terrier, Rat Terrier, Russell Terrier, Scottish Terrier, Sealyham Terrier, Silky Terrier, Skye Terrier, Smooth Fox Terrier, Teddy Roosevelt Terrier, Welsh Terrier, West Highland White Terrier, Wire Fox Terrier, Yorkshire Terrier.

Your dog must be: At least 6 months of age or older. AKC Registered (Limited Registration is acceptable), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) Registered or Foundation Stock Service (FSS) Registered.

Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to enter.

Bitches in season are not eligible to enter.

The **Novice Earthdog** class is open to all eligible breeds of dogs who have not previously earned an Earthdog title.

The **Junior Earthdog** class is open to all eligible breeds of dogs. A dog that has been recorded as a Junior Earthdog may continue to enter the Junior Earthdog test.

The **Senior Earthdog** class is open to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title and to dogs that have been recorded by the AKC as Senior Earthdogs and Master Earthdogs. A dog that has been recorded as a Senior Earthdog may continue to enter the Senior Earthdog test.

The **Master Earthdog** class is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title. A dog that has been recorded as a Master Earthdog may continue to enter the Master Earthdog test.

Any dog that has completed the requirements for the Master Earthdog title shall then be eligible to earn legs toward an **Endurance Earthdog** title. In order to earn an Endurance Earthdog title, a dog must on five occasions pass both the Senior Earthdog test and the Master Earthdog test at the same event.

Any dog that has completed the requirements for the Junior, Senior or Master Earthdog title shall be eligible to earn legs toward the **Earthdog Excellent** title. In order to earn an Excellent title, a dog must on six occasions pass the Junior, Senior or Master level test respectively after the dog has earned its JE, SE or ME title.

Legs that count toward a dog's Excellent title may also be counted toward a dog's Endurance Earthdog title.

For all information regarding eligibility, please refer to Chapter 1 Section 6 of the Regulations for Earthdog Tests for Small Terriers and Dachshunds.

**ENTRY FEES:** IQ (Non-Regular Class) - \$12.00; NE, JE, SE, ME (Regular Classes) - \$20.00, Endurance Earthdog (SE/ME combined) \$36.00. No refund for EE entries that do not run in both classes. No refund for bitches found to be in season after the close of entries. There is NO PRE-ENTRY DISCOUNT.

**FOOD:** The Madison Area Dachshund Club will have lunch available for purchase on Saturday and the West Highland White Terrier Club will have lunch available for purchase on Sunday. Soda and water will be available for purchase.

**RUNNING GROUNDS:** Dogs may be walked on lead within the enclosure after testing is complete each day. Dogs may not be turned loose inside the enclosure, except during testing.

Dachshunds and Beagles are allowed field trial training each day after earthdog testing is complete. Practice is limited to one dog at a time, per handler. Dogs must be under the control of the handler while on the grounds. Handlers who do not have their dogs under control will be asked to remove their dog(s) from the enclosure.

NO dogs on the grounds after dark.

**RUNNING ORDER:** Dogs will be run in the order that entries are received, except for Master which will be braced by random draw. The test committee may modify the running order to keep the event running smoothly.

**WEATHER.** Please bring weather appropriate gear - tests are run rain or shine.

**WITHDRAWN DOGS.** No refund of entry fees after a class has closed. The bracemate of a dog withdrawn from Master Earthdog after bracing will become the bracemate of the bye dog, or become a bye dog.
